Membership Update

Hello again, welcome to a new season of activities with the Dayton chapter. In July we conducted our annual member survey. Our goal was to gain some insight into our members' interests and expectations for the monthly professional development events.

We had some excellent feedback from our more experienced members. In future surveys we'd also love to receive feedback from younger members, those who might one day benefit from visibility to job opportunities exposed by networking with other Dayton Chapter members (2).

In one of the questions, we asked "Why are you a member of ASCM?". Two thirds of responses were 'Professional Affiliation' and 'Networking'. While professional affiliation affords access to education and certification opportunities, which can be helpful from a career perspective, affiliation can also be enriched by volunteering for open positions on the Dayton Chapter Board of Directors. On the networking front, some great feedback from the recent social event at the Troll Pub suggested ice-breaker activities to get people more engaged at the social events themselves.

Another question asked, "Is there a change to the format of the professional development meetings that would encourage you to attend?". The majority of respondents favored social events (e.g. Troll Pub) and team building team events/activities. Also, more zoom and virtual type sessions, which are perhaps better for education, were requested.

In Question 7 we asked, "Which 3 subjects interest you most for professional development speakers?". Topics of greatest interest were Demand and Supply Planning as well as Supply Chain Management.

The Dayton Chapter Board of Directors has reviewed the survey results and will look for opportunities to tailor the event calendar accordingly. Lastly, we'd like to congratulate the two winners of the survey's \$100 gift card sweepstake. Deborah Glass and Jeff Smith each requested an Amazon gift card. Let's hope it's still worth \$100 when they get to spend it!

The Dayton Chapter is holding a CSCP class for our members which started on September 23rd. This is the first CSCP class that we have held in a couple of years. We are also holding a CPIM Part 1 class for NuVasive. This class has NuVasive employees that are located in Memphis TN, San Diego CA, Greensboro NC and one participant that works for their facility outside Amsterdam in the Netherlands. We are utilizing virtual training for both of these classes. Crown Equipment is planning on doing a CPIM Part 1 class in the first quarter of 2022 for their employees. The Chapter also has a quote for a CPIM Part 1 class to FC Industries here in Dayton. We are offering a full slate of CPIM, CSCP, and CLTD classes in early 2022.
