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Education Update

Jack Kerr - Director of Education

We currently have two companies providing CPIM Part 1 training for their employees. NuVasive is putting their third group of employees through the CPIM program. They intend to make this training available to their employees on an ongoing basis which is great news for the Chapter. We also have a new company, Dynapower, based out of Vermont that we are working with on a CPIM Part 1 class. They are providing the classes for their purchasing team. Both companies intend to use the Dayton Chapter of ASCM for the follow on CPIM Part 2 class later in the year. We have also scheduled a new CPIM Part 1 class for Crown Equipment in New Bremen starting

September 30th. Crown has been providing CPIM and CSCP classes to their employees since 2011. We have trained over 150 of their employees during that time. The good news for the Chapter is that they have asked us to do these classes using a hybrid training model. We will be on site at their training facility in New Bremen, OH and broadcasting this training to other Crown facilities located out-of-state. This will be the first time that we have done training for their locations outside of New Bremen. We continue to offer CPIM, CSCP, and CLTD classes to our members. Those classes are scheduled several times throughout the year. **If you're interested in ASCM Certification classes for yourself or your team please feel free to call Jack Kerr at 937-272-4604 (or via email at education@dayton.ascm.org).** He retired three years ago and is getting a little bored so put him to work!

Jack Kerr CPIM, CSCP, CLTD, C.P.M. continues his work with the ASCM/APICS CPIM Subcommittee that reviews all submissions from instructors and students related to the CPIM course materials. He has been working on course content changes that will be launched in 2023. It's a volunteer effort that requires quite a bit of his time but he thinks that those efforts are beneficial to keep the course materials updated. All certification course materials are revised on an annual basis as part of a continuous improvement effort by ASCM/APICS.
